APPLICANT CRITERIA

Applicants for the Railton School for Youth Worker Training should:

1. Be between the ages of 18 and 30
2. Be single
3. Be healthy enough to handle the rigor of the program expectations
4. Have a valid drivers license and a good driving record
5. Be a growing Christian, preferably a soldier of The Salvation Army
6. Exhibit an ability to handle rigorous academic study with at least a high school diploma or GED
7. Already be participating in local ministry to children and youth
8. Exhibit positive social skills in relating to leadership, peers, teens and children
9. Express God's call on their lives to work in Salvation Army frontline ministries specifically focused on marginal children and youth
10. Be supported by their local corps and division
11. Have secured a commitment from the division to be employed in a frontline ministry for a determined period of time
12. Exhibit a growing maturity and potential for leadership in Corps and Community Center settings
13. Be teachable and display a heart that is willing to participate fully in all aspects of the training experience
